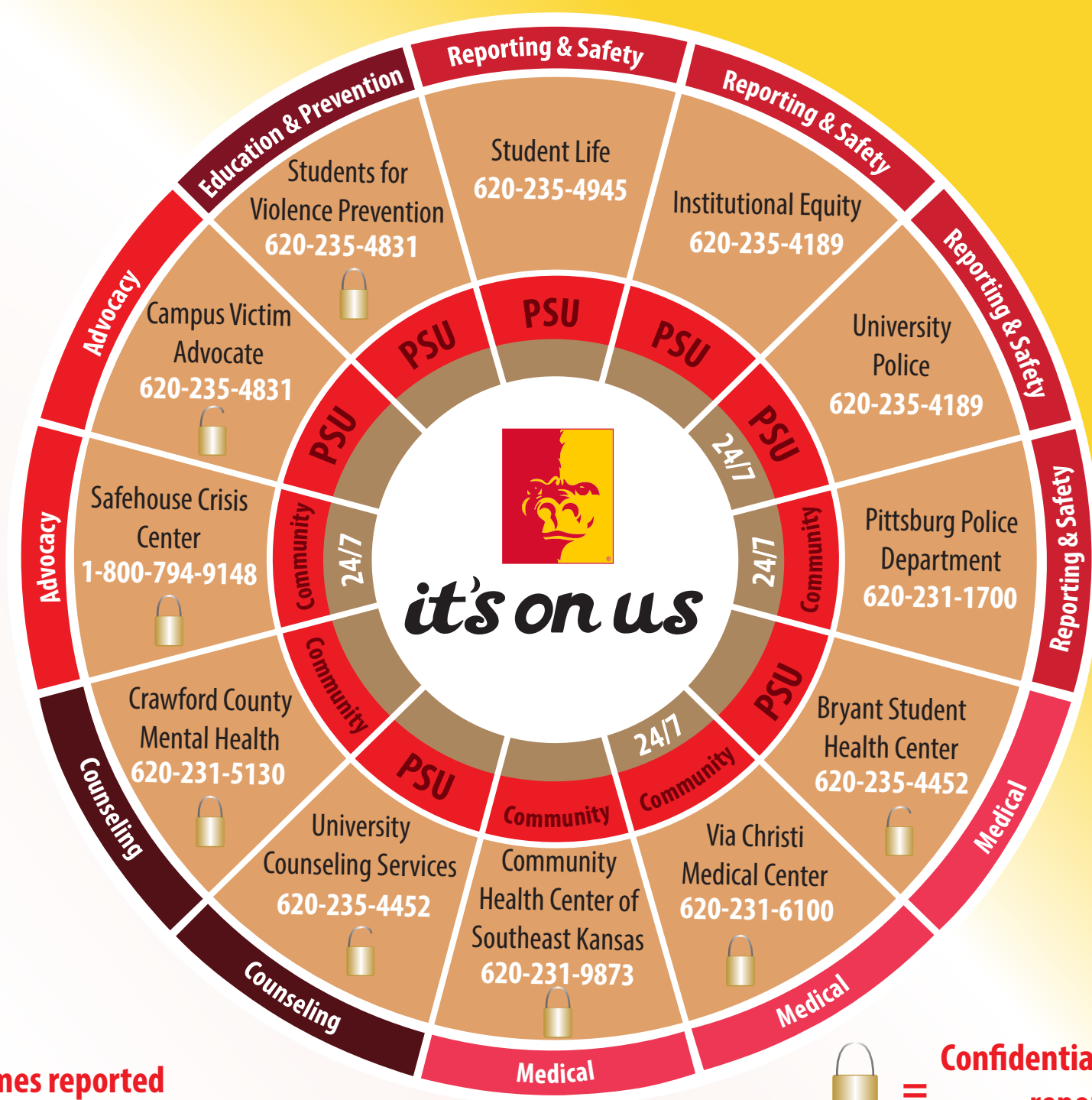


Resources for Sexual & Intimate Partner Violence

Quick Reference Guide



Medical

- Survivors are highly encouraged to seek confidential medical care after any assault.
- Evidence collection by a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) is available at Via Christi Medical Center Emergency Room up to 96 hours after a sexual assault at no cost to the survivor.
- Preventative medication for sexually transmitted infections and/or pregnancy is available.
- Evidence can be collected without reporting and is stored for five years.

Education & Prevention

- Educational presentations and trainings for students, faculty, and staff on a variety of topics related to sexual assault and intimate partner violence are available at no cost:
 - > Escalation Workshop
 - > Healthy Relationships
 - > Sexual Communication & Consent
 - > Bystander Intervention
 - > Trauma Informed Response
 - > Rape Culture

Reporting & Safety

- All students affected by sexual or intimate partner violence are encouraged to file reports.
- Police: Students have the option to provide criminal or informational report only.
- Institutional Equity: Students have the option to report and/or participate in a voluntary internal campus investigation. There are also interim measures available for students (academic assistance, escorts, housing relocations).

Counseling & Advocacy

- Campus Victim Advocate: Is contracted from Safehouse Crisis Center to be on campus providing free and confidential advocacy services including crisis intervention, support counseling, safety planning, support groups, court advocacy, medical advocacy, information, education, and referrals.
- Safehouse Crisis Center: Provides free and confidential advocacy services like the campus victim advocate with the addition of temporary emergency shelter, 24/7 hotline counseling, and counseling from a licensed therapist.
- Counseling: No and low cost therapeutic resources for both acute and historical assault are available on and off campus.
