- ² If ENGL 250 is counted as a General Education course, the student must take one additional English elective course. (ENGL 250 cannot count for both Gen Ed credit and as an English elective.)
- ³ Students should seek advisement from the minor department to find out if any of their required minor courses are offered only in the fall or in the spring or if there are any recommended sequences that students should follow.
- ⁴ Students can take either ENGL 351 in the fall, or they can take ENGL 347 in the spring.
- ⁵ **Literature electives (6 credit hours)**
Selected from literature courses numbered 500 and above; at least three credit hours must be American. Recommendations:
- Take ENGL 304 before any literature classes 500 and above.
 - Take ENGL 230 and 304 before any American literature classes 500 and above.
 - Take ENGL 241, 242, and 304 before any British literature classes 500 and above.
- ⁶ Students can take either ENGL 347 or ENGL 351 or ENGL 752 in the fall, or they can take ENGL 753 in the spring.
