

MGMKT 601 INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCE (3 HOURS CREDIT)
and
MGMKT 821 TOPICS IN BUSINESS - INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCE

NOTE: (a) All International Experiences must be pre-approved by the International Business adviser

(b) Students must enroll in MGMKT 601 (or 821 for MBA) International Experience during the semester that the experience actually takes place.

No credit will be given if (a) and (b) are not followed.

(c) Credit will be given for MGMKT 601 or 821 only. Students are not allowed to count credit toward more than one PSU course (i.e., the experience will not count for International Experience in addition to another PSU course)

For the International Experience requirement, follow these steps:

1. Elect appropriate choice, i.e., Study Abroad or Internship, or Course Work at a foreign university. These choices are outlined at the following website: <http://www.pittstate.edu/departments/marketing/degree-programs/international-experience.dot>
2. Download appropriate form, complete, and submit for approval to Dr. Jay van Wyk, International Business Advisor. Relevant material/information about selected course must be attached to application form. Only International Experiences that are relevant to International Business will be approved.
3. After approval, the International Business adviser will enroll you in either MGMKT 601 or MGMKT 821 for the appropriate semester.
4. A grade will only be assigned after registration and requirements for the course has been met, e.g., submit report after completion of Study Abroad or Internship, transfer of course work credits from foreign university, etc.
