2009 Graduate School Research Colloquium

Goal

To increase awareness and celebrate research activities happening on our campus by showcasing the works of our graduate and undergraduate students.

Guidelines

The Colloquium is open to any PSU graduate or undergraduate student. Graduate students who are engaged in a research project, which includes scholarly projects, theses and creative/artistic work are eligible. Undergraduate research presentations may include presentations by undergraduate students who are working on a faculty research project, have worked on a research project as part of a class or have worked on a research project as part of a student organization activity.

Judging

The competition will be held on April 8, and April 9, 2009 from 1:00-4:30 p.m. in the Hughes Hall Meeting Room, room 316. PSU faculty and staff will be judging the competition. Undergraduate projects will be judged separately from the graduate projects.

Requirements

- Submit the registration form below by 4:30 p.m. on Monday, March 23, 2009 to the Office of Continuing and Graduate Studies. You will receive a confirmation of your presentation time before April 6, 2009.
- Submit a 200-word Abstract to the Office of Continuing and Graduate Studies in 112 Russ Hall by 4:30 p.m. on Monday, March 23, 2009.
- Submit a 4-5 page double spaced paper regarding the project by Wednesday, April 1, 2009.
- Make a 20-minute oral presentation regarding the project at the Colloquium on either April 8, or April 9, 2009.

Note: For those whose research does not lend itself to PowerPoint presentations; please know that although allowed, audio/visual aids are not required. Points can be made in an interesting way without such a presentation. The judges are looking for research methods, conclusions, etc.

Award Presentation

There are three cash prizes: first, second, and third place in both divisions, Graduate and Undergraduate. Award recipients will be recognized at the annual Graduate School Banquet on April 29, 2009.

Other Information

The Graduate School Banquet will be held on April 29, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. in the Crimson and Gold Ballroom, Overman Student Center. Tickets are available for sale in 112 Russ Hall, Continuing and Graduate Studies.

Faculty will be nominating student theses for the Distinguished Thesis Award and winners will be recognized at the Graduate School Banquet.
