Apply Now for the eLearning Academy

The CTLT is taking applications to participate in our year-long eLearning Academy cohort group. The purpose of the Academy is to help bring consistency to the design of online and hybrid courses. The Quality Matters Rubric is used as a guide for assessing course design.

Requirements

Any faculty who is teaching or is preparing to teach an **online or hybrid course** is invited to apply. Here is a quick list of activities required of our Cohort members:

- Participate in online training from Quality Matters and from CTLT (Summer '17)
- Design or re-design a designated course (Summer - Fall)
- Attend monthly meetings in the fall
- Submit your course to be reviewed in the spring of 2018
- Attend professional development events in the CTLT
