Definition

Term	Definition
Tobacco	Tobacco is defined as all tobacco-derived or containing products, including and not limited to , cigarettes (e.g., clove, bidis, kreteks), electronic cigarettes, cigars and cigarillos, hookah smoked products, pipes and oral tobacco (e.g., spit and spitless tobacco, smokeless, chew, snuff, snus) and any product intended to mimic tobacco products. This policy also includes any newly devised tobacco or nicotine delivery products promoted by tobacco industries that are not recognized as cessation devices by the Food and Drug Administration.
