

MODERN LANGUAGES FACULTY POSITION

- POSITION:** Instructor in French. Twelve-hour teaching load. One year, renewable position. Scholarship and service required.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Doctorate (or A.B.D. for initial appointment) in French. Native or near-native fluency and a special area of scholarship are required. Ability to teach introductory levels of Spanish preferred. Evidence of effective teaching required. Demonstrated ability to attract and retain students preferred.
- STARTING DATE:** August 20, 2008
- TERMS OF APPOINTMENT:** Academic year appointment. Salary from a base of \$35,000.
- DEPARTMENTAL PROFILE:** The Department of Modern Languages and Literatures has five full-time faculty members. Degrees offered by the department are the B.A. and the B.S.Ed. with majors in French and Spanish.
- UNIVERSITY, SCHOOL, AND COMMUNITY PROFILE:** Pittsburg State University is a comprehensive state-supported institution with an enrollment of approximately 6,500 students. The University serves the southeast portion of Kansas and surrounding areas of Arkansas, Missouri, and Oklahoma. Pittsburg is a community of 20,000 located in southeast Kansas 100 miles south of Kansas City and 25 miles northwest of Joplin, Missouri. The Joplin airport is located approximately 22 miles from Pittsburg.
