

## PSU fans plan KC road trip

PSU alumni and Gorilla football fans are planning two days of activities in preparation for the big game between the Gorillas and Northwest Missouri State University in Arrowhead Stadium on Oct. 29. Kickoff for the game, known as the Fall Classic at Arrowhead IV, is at 2 p.m.

The fun begins on Friday, Oct. 28, at the PSU Gathering at the 810 Zone at 119<sup>th</sup> Street & Roe in Overland Park, Kan. From 2-6 p.m., Kansas City area sports personality Kevin Kietzman will conduct a live remote broadcast from the restaurant. Gorilla fans will fill the restaurant that afternoon and late into the evening.

On Saturday, the Washington, D.C., sextet The Lloyd Dobbler Effect will be the featured band in the Pavilion at Arrowhead Stadium for Pittsburg State University's GorillaFest celebration, a free tailgate party that begins at 11 a.m.

The Lloyd Dobbler Effect describes its style as "popular rock with Latin rhythms and go-go beats." The band maintains a grueling schedule with up to 250 performances a year up and down the East Coast, in other parts of the U.S. and internationally. Their most recent CD is "Live 2004."

The band has been nominated for the Wammie awards in 2003 & 2004, including Best New Artist, Rock Band of the Year, Song of the Year and Songwriter of the Year by the Washington Area Music Association. Several of their songs are now available through iTunes. In addition to the Lloyd Dobbler Effect, GorillaFest will include a variety of food vendors and game-day activities for football fans.

Food vendors include Zarda Barbecue, the Hereford House, Levy's Corner Grill and Sheridan's Frozen Custard. Zarda will offer beef, ham or turkey, pulled pork and burnt end sandwiches as well as ribs and sides for prices ranging from \$5 to \$8. The Hereford House will have grilled smokehouse chicken sandwiches for \$7, French dip sandwiches for \$8, steak soup for \$4, and salads topped with steak or chicken for \$7-\$9. Levy's menu includes chili, burgers, beer bratwurst and hot dogs ranging from \$4 to \$6.50. Sheridans will serve a 12 oz. cup with toppings for \$4.50. Additionally, there will be a variety of soft drinks and beer available.
