Topic: Senate Membership

WHEREAS: The Student Government Association follows the Constitution of the organization; and,

WHEREAS: The makeup of the Senate is to be defined in the Constitution; and,

WHEREAS: The Constitution does not properly specify the full makeup of the Senate;

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE PITTSBURG STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE HERE ASSEMBLED: That Article IV, Section 1 of the current Constitution be amended to read "The Student Senate shall be composed of 32 senators. Two (2) senators from each college, ten (10) senators from the University at-large and the remaining ten (10) senators to be assigned proportionally to each college as determined by the full-time enrollment of each of those schools, elected by the students thereof. **Two (2) senators shall be members of the faculty, selected by the Association President from a panel of five (5) nominated by the Faculty Senate. The remaining two (2) senators will be graduate senators elected by the student body, or in instance of vacancy will be appointed by the Association President.**"
