Dr. Pomatto called the meeting to order at 3:00PM.

Dr. Joey Pogue introduced legislation for the Communication Department. Dept proposes revision of the Graduate Certificate in Communication to offer the 50% or more of the degree online. Also to delete COMM 726, 785, 795 from candidacy, to add COMM 601 and 629, and to change the title of COMM 884 from Readings in Communication (independent study in communication theory) to COMM 884 Readings in Communication (independent study in area of interest). Motion and second to approve (Winters, Bonnekessen). Discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Tim Flood presented legislation for the Mathematics Department. Dept requests revision to MATH 307 to change prerequisites and course description, revision to MATH 636 to change when the course is offered in the description to "offered fall semester" rather than spring, and revision to MATH 705 to change prerequisites and clean up course description. Motion and second to approve three revisions (Bonnekessen, Pogue). Discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

Dr. John Ross presented legislation for the Music Department. Department proposes changes to the Bachelor of Music Education in both the Instrumental and Vocal tracts. Change will add EDUC 261 Explorations Education (3 hrs) and drop MUSIC 241 Introduction to Music Education (1 hr). Motion and second (Winters, Pogue) to approve. Discussion centering on number of hours in the major if increased by two credit hours and already over the Bd or Regents max of 120. Dr. Ross said the department is tackling that issue separately. Motion passed unanimously.
