- I. PLC Update
 - a. Miscellaneous – Summer Innovation Grants / Prioritization Consultant / Projector Bulbs / Etc.
 - i. Discussed alternative summer innovation grants review processes.
 - ii. Program Prioritization consultants – exploring who to hire.
 - iii. Techs will be installing bulbs, but ITS has requested that bulbs be replaced every 1500 hours instead of when they burn out. Discussion followed – cost a major concern.
 - b. Summer School Task Force Report
 - i. Summer School Task force was discussed at PLC. Dr. Murray served on task force for KCOB.
 - ii. There were not many recommendations from the task force, but outlined alternative structures for administration to consider moving forward – class size limits, contingent contracts, etc.
 - iii. Summer tuition expenses at PSU limit lower division enrollments.
 - c. Program Review for Accredited Programs – KBOR pushback on last year's practice
 - i. There is a new model for accredited programs which applies to KCOB.
 - ii. KBOR has stated that program review for accredited programs was not rigorous enough; new plan will be implemented this year.
