- I. PLC Updates
 - a. Summer Innovation Grant proposals – only 3 submitted this year which were not approved – did not adequately address enrollment goals. Will devise new approach and reallocate funding to assist programs rather than individual projects.
 - b. Strategic Visioning Initiative – 4 proposals - have been ranked and one has been set aside. Dr. Grimes has proposed to include info about this initiative at the Kelce spring opening faculty meeting.
 - c. Admissions Criteria – Dr. Smith – working on making “qualified admissions” criteria more flexible in order to attract more students to PSU.
