- I. PLC Updates
 - a. Discussion: campus space and KCOB's need for space during renovation and expansion of the building.
 - i. Dean Grimes will prepare memo to Provost Olson requesting that space in Whitesitt and Hartman Halls be reserved for our relocation needs.
 - ii. KLT will try to view space in Axe Library where Academic Advising will probably be housed.
 - b. State Health Plan – the State is automating state health insurance deductions for 9 and 10 month faculty. Changes forthcoming, wait for official announcement.
 - c. Summer salary proposals was discussed at length. Colleges have been asked to change proposals to reflect how funds were spent last summer. New proposals are due on December 17.
 - d. Administrative Task force to review non-tenure earning faculty.
 - i. Will create a proposal for full-time non-tenure earning faculty – need to recognize professional advancement and progression; design ranks and promotion criteria
 - ii. Consider differences between full-time temporary instructors continuing instructors.
 - e. Strategic Visioning Initiative
 - i. Interviewing the last of the proposed consultants today. Provost Olson to make decision prior to holiday break.

 - a. KUSB – adjuncts have been hired for spring; working with summer budget; have met with all undergraduate faculty
 - b. KGSB – visited with a new professional MBA student who drove in from St. Louis today; there are currently 35 students enrolled in the professional MBA program which starts in January; working on MPAcc – 3.25 GPA is to be required instead of 3.0 and must complete paperwork for this change to be approved by Graduate Council
 - c. OBE – Provost Search Committee started meeting this week; Gorilla Gateway committee has started meetings; taking Business Gus pictures tomorrow morning at 11:00
 - d. AACR – Kelce curriculum committee meetings are taking place regarding new General Education issues; Enactus Advisory Board meeting was last week – meeting was very informative; January 9 - Enactus Regional rep will be on campus; January 11 is Pitt Cares for the spring semester; Phi Beta Lambda discussion and how to start initiating the organization at PSU;
