- I. Administrative Issues
 - a. Alternative Grading Scheme
 - i. Grad Council passed modified grading scale – Ds to be recorded as Fs
 - ii. UG students are having problems getting into the system to record their choices – Registrar is working with ITS on this issue.
 - b. Budgets – consensus state revenue forecast released yesterday; Kansas revenues expected to be down \$1.27 Billion!
 - i. Discussed e-mail that was sent out to campus yesterday to limit future expenditures.
 - c. Reorganization – deans to have proposal by end of summer; discussions in fall; finalize in spring; implement following fiscal year. Shouldn't have a big impact on KCOB unless programs are added.

 - b. DOBE – Lynn Murray, student employee is continuing to send e-mails and making calls for recruiting purposes; working on checklist of items to complete for the sales center certificate program – goal is to establish this center by fall
 - c. KGSB – Din Cortes, PMBA students having issues with enrollment for fall – working with ITS to resolve these issues; PMBA ETEC 804 course – Graduate council will not approve graduate status for proposed course instructor – Dr. Cortes is working to add course as a MGT course and will reapply for graduate status for instructor
 - d. KUSB – Steve Horner, working on summer staffing and budget; currently discussing with David Hogard the need to put together something for students about the P/F grading scheme; reviewing course catalog links that are not working – GA will work on this
