I. Kelce Building update

- 1. KLT discussed building needs and how to proceed with the project while in Atlanta at the AACSB Conference (Binder, Cortes, Decker, Grimes, Murray).
 - a. Driving factor is to provide an academic home for business students.
 - b. A consensus was made at the meeting to advocate for a new academic home downtown with a small presence on campus.
 - i. This will include sharing spaces with the city.
 - ii. Discussed encouraging administration to house the new facility on the southeast corner of 4th & Broadway.
 - iii. President Shipp has stated that he can raise enough funds for Kelce to have a new building in the downtown area.
 - iv. There is a possibility of making Locust street a green space from PSU to 4th Street.

2. Transition Advisory Council

- a. Entire committee met yesterday. Representatives from Kelce were Din Cortes, Chelsey Decker and David Weaver.
- b. Part of the discussion was on city and university partnerships.
- c. Provost Smith gave a report on Academic Affairs and showcased Kelce.
 - i. Business Studies BBA was high-lighted

- e. International student numbers are slowly increasing close to 300 students this semester.
- f. Centralized advising model plan to have in place next semester.
- g. Will be creating full-year of class schedules going forward.
