



## Introduction to NFPA 70E and Short-Circuit Currents and Calculations

This 6-hour training provides introduction into workplace electrical safety requirements as they are addressed in the NFPA® document 70E-2012 (3.0 NON-Code hours). This same event also provides detail into the importance of determining the available fault current on an electrical system for electrical equipment selection (3.0 Code hours). Workplace electrical safety is mandated by OSHA. The consensus document for maintaining compliance is the NFPA 70E<sup>®</sup>. The training addresses document layout, content, history, terminology, and its integration for OSHA compliance. This course will address the hazards associated with electric arc flash, mitigating those hazards, personal protective equipment selection, and determining protection boundaries. The day of training also provides insight into the proper selection of equipment to maintain compliance with Sections 110.9, 110.10, and 110.24 of the 2011 NEC<sup>®</sup>. Proper selection of equipment requires understanding and calculating available fault current at strategic distribution locations. Both are explored in the training session. This part of the training utilizes the published coursework "2011 NEC<sup>®</sup> Electrical Calculations", published by C&M Enterprises. While NEC<sup>®</sup> codebooks (always recommended) may be helpful, this course is designed to provide all the necessary information to explain, comprehend and complete the calculations without additional materials. This course is especially suited for master and journeyman electricians, design professionals and others with a need-to-know regarding the basic fault calculation processes required for NEC<sup>®</sup> compliance, as well as an understanding of workplace electrical safety governed under NFPA 70E<sup>®</sup>


