Recreation practicum

- Is there criteria in the practicum for the expectation of student/supervisor
 - May help in both the organization and student in understanding expectations
 - Each emphasis area writes their own expectations/criteria of expectations for practicum experience
 - Create a pre-approved list for locations and include contact information
- 45 hours at two or three organizations
 - Example – 20 hours at one organization, 25 hours at another
 - Minimum of 15 hours
 - Follow up with Opp – practicum for PE – Rick follow up with Dr. Opp
- Legislation for pre-req needed – fall 2021/spring 2022
- How practicum work for certificate seeking students
 - Would need legislation

Internship – change to require to be completed either junior or senior year

- 24 hours in upper division courses – 300 level and above
- 100 – 200 level courses do not count in the required 24 hours
- Require to take practicum before their internship
 - Need to think about transfer students – this is what it looks like if you want to do your internship at the end of your junior year
- Legislation would need to happen for change in pre-reqs
- Legislation for academic year fall 2021/spring 2022

Pre-Internship Seminar (Professional Development) – legislation for academic year fall 2021/spring 2022

- Change to professional development course
- Need to take before the practicum
- Change pre-reqs for legislation if needed
 - Currently 160 or 240, etc. look at wording
 - Pre-req to practicum and internship, have to take intro course prior to enrolling in professional development course
