Requirements for Full Admission to Pittsburg State University's Master of Science in Reading Program:

- Graduate School application
- Copy of valid teaching license/certificate
- Evidence of classroom teaching experience
- Two recommendations (Graduate Study Recommendation Form) completed by a public school administrator, a peer teacher, and/or university instructor.
- In alignment with state licensure requirements, Pittsburg State University requires all education majors applying to teacher education to complete a background check with Validity Screening Solutions Background check.
- Conditional entry: If overall GPA is below 3.0 on undergraduate degree, candidate will be admitted on the condition that a 3.0 is maintained in the first 9 hours of coursework. NOTE: A GPA of 3.0 is required for successful completion of this program.

Specific guidelines and submission directions for each of the above items can be found on the attached documents. Please note, all requirements must be met within the first 9 hours of the program.
