Master of Science with a Major in Educational Technology

The Master of Science degree with a major in Educational Technology is designed to prepare curriculum and technology leaders in educational settings. Two areas of specialization are offered within the degree: Technology Integration Specialists and Library Media Specialists. Candidates who select the technology integration emphasis prepare to lead in instructional design, technology integration, and instructional coaching. Candidates who select the library media emphasis prepare to direct library resource centers in elementary, middle, and/or secondary schools. For this emphasis, recommendation for licensure as a school library media specialist will be an expected end result.

Admission Requirements:

- Application to the PSU Graduate School
- Cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better in undergraduate major. If not, the candidate must maintain a 3.0-grade point average during their first nine hours of graduate coursework
- Completion of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- Evidence of a professional teaching license* or experience in an educational setting
- Two College of Education Recommendation Forms
- Background check

Procedural Steps for Master's Degree and/or Licensure:

1. The student must fulfill the admission requirements for the Educational Technology program.
2. The student must apply for candidacy in conference with the advisor within the first 12 hours of coursework.
3. The student must petition the Graduate Office to graduate. All official transcripts from other institutions must be on file in the Graduate Office.
4. The student must pass all tests as required by KSDE (Praxis for School Library Media only).
5. The candidate must satisfactorily pass the e-portfolio at the end of the program.
