Requirements for Admission to Pittsburg State University's Specialist in Education Degree Program  
(Requirements must be submitted as soon as possible but prior to the completion of the first 6 graduate hours of coursework.

- Three (3) letters of recommendation to accompany a completed Graduate Study Recommendation form from the following: A current or previous supervisor, a school board member or professional colleague, and a former graduate school professor who will attest, with examples as to the student's potential as an educational leader.

- A written leadership autobiography sketch describing the leadership roles the student has assumed during his/her life.

- Academic writing sample: research paper the candidate has completed.

- Teaching/Administrative License

- Background check. In alignment with state licensure requirements, Pittsburg State University requires all education majors who are applying to educational administration to complete a background check with Validity Screening Solutions Background check.
