Requirements for Admission to Pittsburg State University's Master of Science in Teaching Program

(Requirements must be submitted as soon as possible but prior to the completion of the first 12 hours of coursework.)

*Bachelor's Degree in Education

*Meet all COE/KSDE requirements for licensure

NOTE: Exception for International students and others seeking MS Degree only—without Licensure

*Copy of valid teaching license/certificate. Please send the copy to your program advisor.

*Two recommendations (Graduate Study Recommendation Form) from a public school administrator, a peer teacher, and/or university instructor

*Writing sample based upon Knowledge Base (Please see attached prompt, rubric, and knowledge base.)

*Background check. In alignment with state licensure requirements, Pittsburg State University requires all education majors who are applying to teacher education to complete a background check with Validity Screening Solutions Background check. Please refer to the Criminal Background Check Instructions for further information.

*Conditional entry: If overall GPA is below 3.0 on undergraduate degree, candidate will be admitted on condition that a 3.0 is maintained in the first 12 hours of coursework. NOTE: A GPA of 3.0 is required for successful completion of this program.
