FACULTY SENATE MINUTES September 29, 2025

The Pittsburg State University Faculty Senate met at 3:00 p.m. on Monday, September 29, 2025, with David Weaver, President, presiding.

Past Minutes

Announcements

Provost and Vice President of Academic Affairs – Dr. Susan Bon

Provost Bon shared that they are working on an RFP to hire a search firm for the College of Education Dean position. Travel PD funds are being awarded. Currently \$36,000 of the \$65,000 has been allocated, and the typical turn around on an application is one week. Faculty were encouraged to continue to apply. Funds will continually be reviewed. This year funds increased from \$50,000 to \$65,000. Provost Bon has created two task forces, one for travel and one for Al. Additional task forces will be created as necessary to discuss topics that came up during KNEA negotiations. The IRB handbook/policies are forthcoming. Lastly, Provost Bon reported that President's Cabinet is likely to rescind the policy on class attendance and faculty drops. As part of this action, a path to recommend a withdrawal will be established. Faculty are encouraged to contact Provost Bon with any feedback.

President Jayawardhana reported that the contract has been ratified and approved by KBOR. The contract term is three years except for salary which is discussed annually.
