- Call to Order

- Review August/September minutes
 - August's meeting minutes were tabled in September's meeting due to the departure of Ann Courtney, Secretary. Diane Letner provided September's meeting minutes.
 - Jeannice asked senators to verify they received the meeting minutes from August and September.
 Jerrica Lair motioned to approve meeting minutes, Carrol Bell seconded the motion, and it was passed.
- Deatrea Rose, Guest Speaker You and Equity
 - o Reviewed 2020 Pittsburg State University Campus Climate Survey Results
 - Results are posted on the Office of Student Diversity webpage under Results Campus Climate Survey
 - https://www.pittstate.edu/office/diversity/_files/documents/2020-pittsburg-state-university-campus-climate-survey
 - Response rate
 - 1827 students from 6400 students in sample size responded for a 28.5% response rate. Students included those on campus and online, and all classifications freshmen through graduate students
 - National response rate for students is 8-10%
 - 587 faculty, staff and administrators from 896 in sample size responded for a 65.5% response rate
 - 33.1% total response rate (2418 out of 7296)
 - o Recommendations
 - Goal is to make sure that everyone is heard and seen and knows that we are listening and actively working to increase inclusivity
 - Faculty, staff and students will be invited to participate in brown bag lunches to discuss diversity issues starting on November 2nd or 3rd
 - An email with more information will be sent out
 - Each lunch session will have 8-10 people and be an open and welcoming space to discuss all things DE&I
 - o What do you see? What do you want to change?
 - Students groups will be separate from faculty and staff
 - There are six scheduled opportunities to attend with more possible sessions after spring break
 - Virtual diversity workshop facilitated by Everfi
 - Workshop is not mandatory but everyone is encouraged to complete the workshop at their own pace
 - There are five modules but only one will be launched at a time
 - Faculty and Staff have until December 10th to complete the first module

- Working more with HRS on how PSU hirers employees and where vacant positions are posted and advertised
- Trainings with departments
 - Openly engage in conversations
 - Training topics can include DE&I topics, how to engage people in conversations, trauma training, etc.
- Deatra closed with a challenge to all present to think about how we can increase inclusivity in our areas
 - Who is hired, including student employees? Are they from similar backgrounds who look like you? Consider what we can learn from hiring someone from a different background.

 - Revenue is down 1.5 million from what was expected. PSU is prepared for a shortage but everyone needs to remain frugal. At this time there have not been talks about cuts or layoffs, but everyone is encouraged to recruit and help retain students

- Kansas Regent Universities Joint UPS-USS Report- Terri Blessent
 - Terri out of office today Similar to Mary Jo's report

 - Retention is just as important as enrollment. Think about the atmosphere PSU provides to its students and how it connects with and supports students
 - o State finances are 162 million above projected
