Note to Dependent Students

Please refer to the information listed below in determining who is considered a parent for purposes of this form.

(Note that grandparents, foster parents, and legal guardians are not considered parents on this form unless they have legally adopted you.)

- ◆ If your parents (biological or adoptive) are both living and married to each other regardless of gender, include them both in the household listing and base this questionnaire on their household.
- ◆ If your parent (biological or adoptive) is widowed or never married, include this parent in the household listing and base this questionnaire on his/her household. If your widowed parent is remarried as of the date you completed the FAFSA, include the parent **and** the person to whom your parent is married (your stepparent).
- ◆ If your parents (biological or adoptive) have divorced or separated, only include in the household listing the parent you lived with more during the past 12 months, and base this questionnaire on his/her household. Note to Independent Students
