- The KRPS radio station is moving to the Bicknell Center.
- The next H. Lee Scott Series Speaker will be April 4th, the speaker will be announced soon.
- Domestic admission applications are up, this may be due to the November state wide application fee waiver, even though we already didn't have an application fee.
- The new FSFA form will be released December 31st. We will receive the data February 1st this may impact how we consider giving awards.
- Faculty Senate agreed to have faculty automatically signed up for RAVE.
- There is a new campus wide scheduling system that will be used by the Student Center, Bicknell Center, and Gorilla Rising. This system will not be used for instructional spaces.
- Police and Public Safety will be moving to the second floor of Horace Mann after Student Success moves back to the library.
- We are in good shape with centralized advising, for the NISS updates in January.
- The schedule of classes will need to be determined three semesters out. This will be necessary for the new Student Information System, it will help us predict enrollment and will help with financial aid.

- Faculty Senate has a committee looking at syllabi. The SGA President would like to have something included to notify students what to do when classes might be canceled due to circumstances, such as weather, a water issue, etc.
- KNEA's Executive Committee and study groups are reviewing complex topics.
- There will be a national search for the Provost position.
