Rename MS Teaching for all emphasis areas (Elementary, Secondary, ESOL, and Environmental Health) to MS Curriculum and Instruction

Dr. Mascher shared that this name change would help eliminate confusion, of what the program is. Dr. Clemensen shared that it would also make it clear that it is different from the Master of Arts Teaching program.

Dr. Smetana moved for approval, Dr. Binder seconded and the motion carried.

Navigate Updates

Dr. Mascher shared that since the council wanted to use Navigate, there are a couple of graduate programs set up as pilot programs to begin using Navigate.

Proposed Changes to the membership section of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Graduate School

Dr. Mascher shared that the proposed changes to the Bylaws are only for the "Membership" section. The committee reviewing the Bylaws agreed that other changes should not be

proposed at this time since we will soon have a new Provost. The proposed changes will make sure that all areas are included regardless of if they are referred to as a department or a school.

Dr. Sims moved for approval, Dr. Clemensen seconded and the motion carried.

There was discussion on the changes to the Digital Data Security-Human Subject Research policy. Dr. Jennifer Richardson a member of the Institutional Review Board (IRB) was present at the meeting and responded to questions from the council.
