CURRENT LANGUAGE:

To satisfy the proof of Language Proficiency, international students can either submit a TOEFL or IELTS score result or provide official documentation that the undergraduate degree was taught in the English language (for countries that do not require the TOEFL).

SUGGESTED LANGUAGE:

To satisfy the proof of Language Proficiency, international students whose native language is not English must submit official, acceptable test scores for either the TOEFL or IELTS or PTE.
