

GSAC Meeting Minutes

April 12, 2021 at a pm via Zoom

- I. Welcome - B.B. Stotts admitted participants to join the Zoom meeting. Attendees included seven participants - Mary Whiteacre, Megan Munger, Latayzia Harris, Davis Erickson, Kevin Stalsberg, Jenifer McDonald and B.B Stotts.
- II. Minutes from March 8, 2021 meeting - emailed on March 12, 2021. Latayzia opened the meeting and asked for the minutes to be approved as submitted.
- III. University Committee Representation/Reports - Latayzia thanks committee volunteers.
 - A. Library Services Committee - Jenifer McDonald - reported:
 1. Gail Yarick is currently the chair due to Stella Hastings out on leave.
 2. There is money set aside for articles that PSU cannot get. Talk to Interlibrary loan to get the articles purchased.
 3. Canopy streaming video-if you need a license for a full year, ask the library.
 4. There is a virtual boot camp for how to write an article in PubLinks. April 19th is the deadline to register (faculty and staff only).
 5. Committee is working on updated policies and procedures.
 6. Basic remodeling will have certain sections of the library closed to the public.

if any changes can be made. GSAC requested to have the hooding ceremony of graduate students at commencement and the possibility to allow more guest.

1. B.B. talked to the Provost – they are open to some of the options, including the hooding ceremony; moving from 4 guest to 6 guests; format and times are the same. Thanks, given to Kevin for the letter sent voicing our concerns.
- C. **Blue Parking Permit for G.A.'s** - Davis sent a very professional letter to Dr. Erwin which fixed the issue for next fall, however he suggests that someone follow-up this summer. Starting 2021-2022 academic year, G.A.'s will have the option to purchase a Blue Parking permit.
 1. B.B. talked with the Provost and they will send a file that lists all GAs to Dr. Erwin for the option of G.A.'s to purchase a Blue Permit at full price, approximately \$100. G.A.'s will go to University Parking with their University ID to get the option to trade in their Brown Permit to purchase a Blue Permit. Thank you to Davis.

- B. Elections
