# Bryant Student Health Center

The Bryant Student Health Center is located on campus at the corner of Broadway and Lindburg and provides both health and counseling services to students.

As part of tuition, all students are eligible to receive services from the health center. From a financial perspective, it is usually the most affordable healthcare option for students.

SUMMER SERVICE: Students who were enrolled for the spring semester, not attending in the summer session, but pre-enrolled for fall semester, are eligible for Health Center services for a nominal fee.

Some services available at the BSHC are:

- Treatment of acute illnesses and injuries
- Pharmacy services
- Laboratory services
- Physical examinations
- ♦ Women's health visits
- ♦ Allergy/Immunology
- In house clinics with some local specialists (including orthopedics, dermatology, gynecology, cardiology)

### Mental Health

If you have any mental health issues or are at risk, schedule an appointment to meet with a counseling staff member on campus prior to the start of the school year. You will get better care if you have a crisis when you already know a counselor and have a wellness and prevention plan in place. Establishing good self-care habits makes adapting to college easier. Mental health and physical health are deeply connected and it helps to remember that stress management and adequate sleep are essential to learning and knowledge recall.

#### **Immunizations**

In accordance to Pittsburg State University's Immunization Compliance policy, Bryant Student Health Center (BSHC) <u>must</u> receive evidence of the student's compliance with proof of **two MMRs** and **Meningitis (ACWY) vaccine within the past 5 years**. In the absence of this evidence an enrollment hold will be applied and the student will be unable to enroll in subsequent semesters. You may submit your immunizations here:
