Items to leave at home

- Printers of any kind

Helpful move-in day tips

- We ask that only the student come in to the hall to pickup their keys at the initial check-in. After the student receives their keys, the people helping them move-in are able to enter the building.
- Bring the essentials, Wal-Mart is a short 4 miles down the road. You won't need as much as you think.
- Elevators will not be in service for move-in day unless needed for ability reasons (elevators are only in Nation, Dellinger, and Willard Halls).
