## INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM

- Established Intensive English Program offering three levels of instruction: Elementary, Intermediate and Advanced
- Full-time language instruction, in-person and online, and pre-academic training featuring two 8-week sessions per semester.
- Students who successfully graduate from IEP may begin their college coursework at PSU (exceptions: Psychology, Nursing and English)
- Tuition/Fees: **\$3,370** (per 8-week session)

## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

### Admission Requirement:

Grade Point Average (GPA): 2.5 on a 4.0 Scale  
SAT/ACT not required

### English Requirement:

TOEFL: 68 overall with 15 section scores

IELTS: 6.0 overall with 5.0 section scores

PTE: 47 overall

DUOLINGO: 100 overall with 100 section scores

\*Conditional admission can be offered to students who do not have an English test score or if the score is too low. Students conditionally admitted must complete the Intensive English Program before enrolling in academic coursework.
