CHOOSE YOUR PROGRAM

Faculty-Led:

1-4 weeks, led by a PSU professor, travel with PSU students

Exchange:

normally 1 semester, pay PSU tuition, study at a partner university

Affiliate:

"all-inclusive" programs, study with other American students, different lengths and locations
