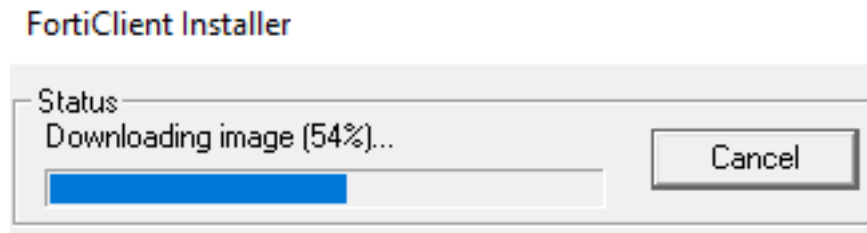
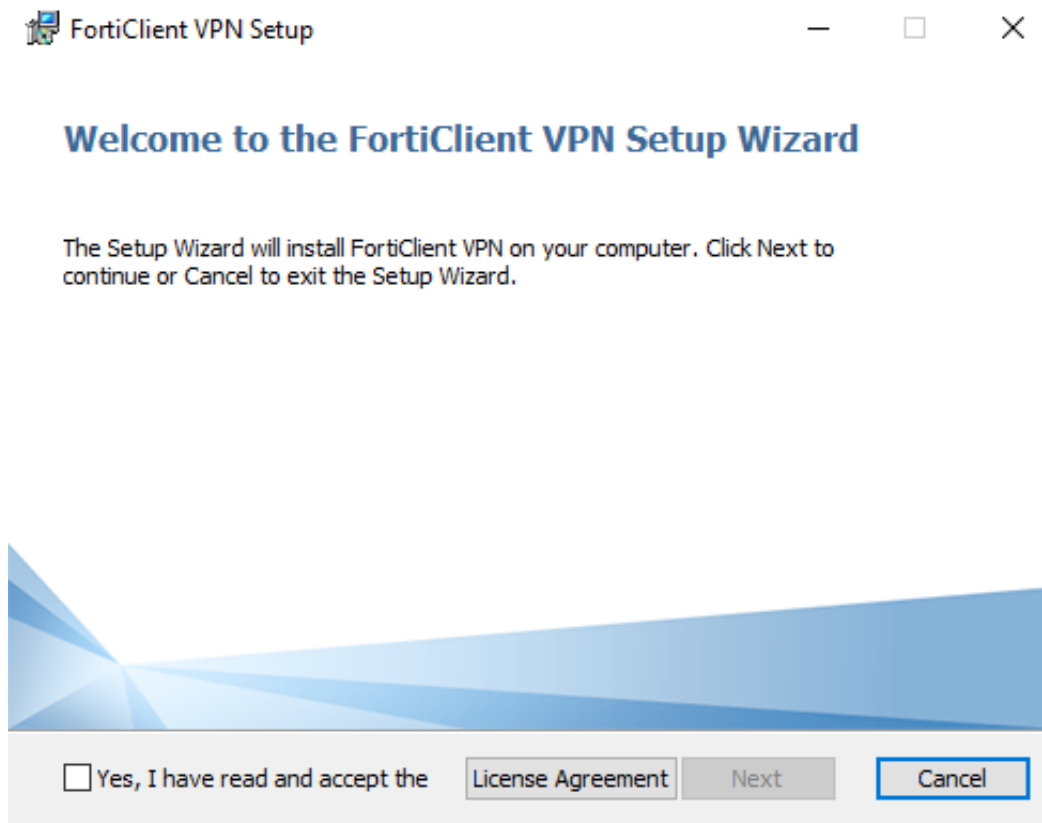


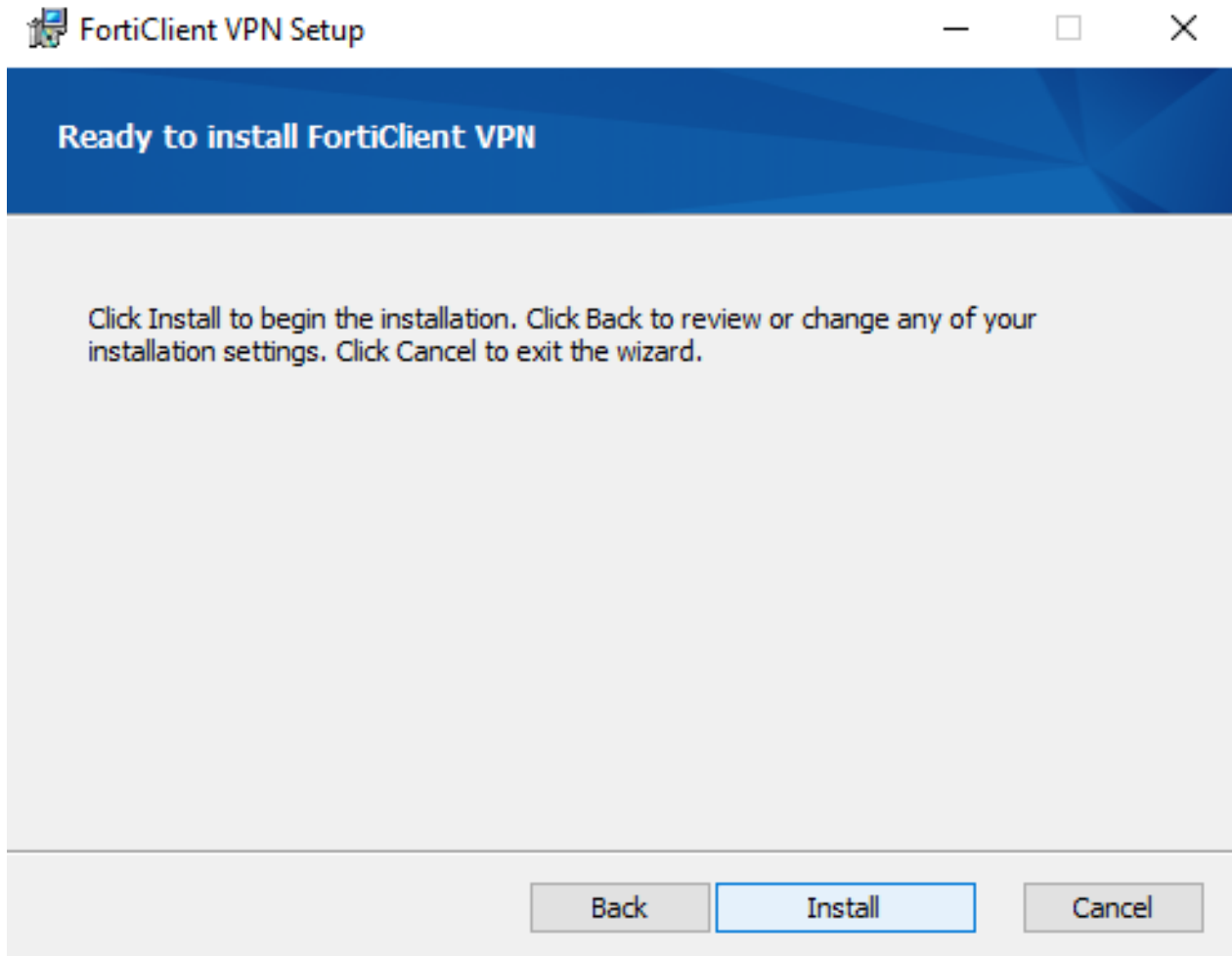
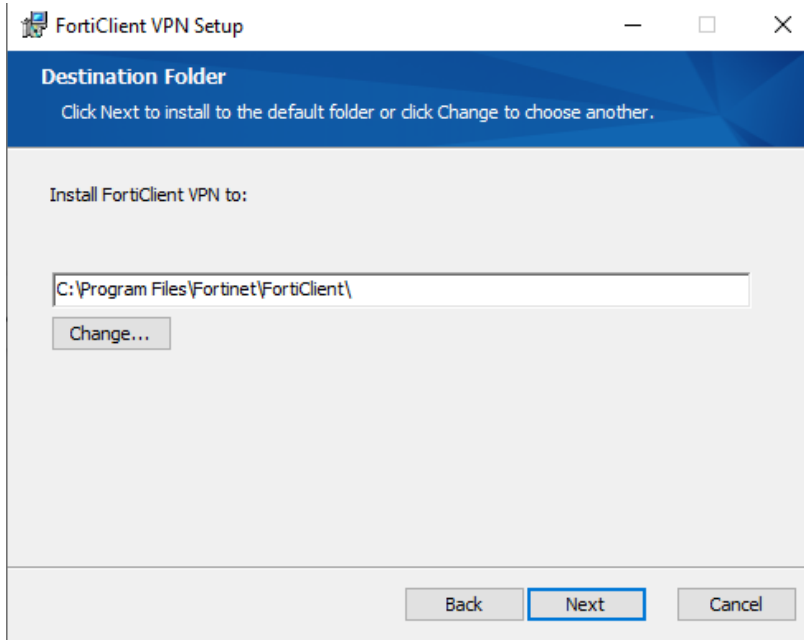
How to download and install Forticlient VPN for your Windows PC

1. Navigate your browser to <https://links.fortinet.com/forticlient/win/vpnagent>



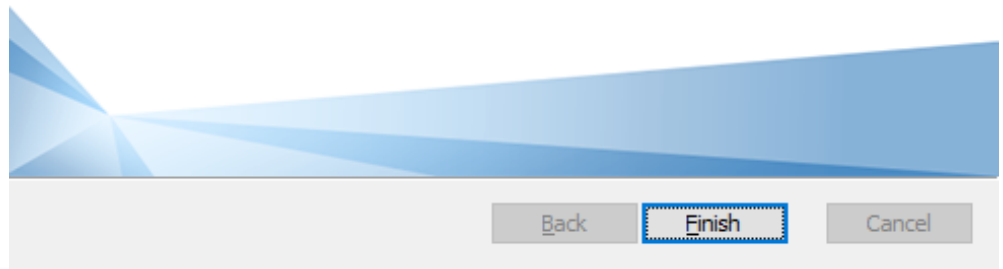
2. Run the downloaded FortiClient installer. You will need to check the "Yes, I have read and accept the license agreement". Then click "next, next, install, finish to complete the install.





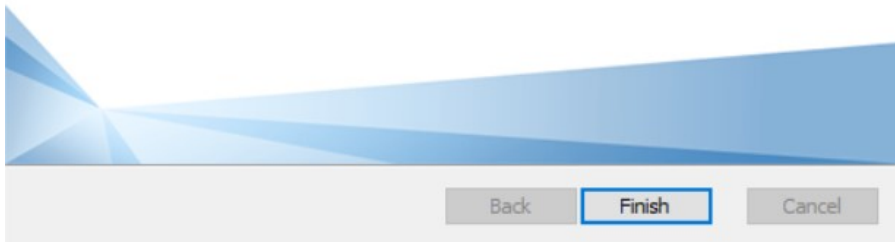

Click the Finish button to exit the Setup Wizard.

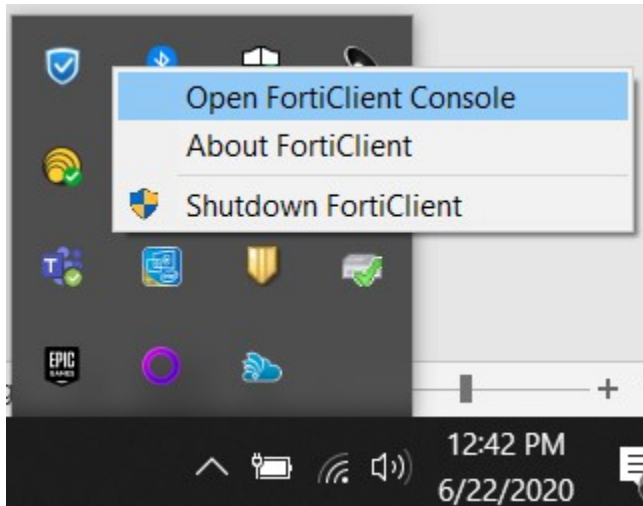

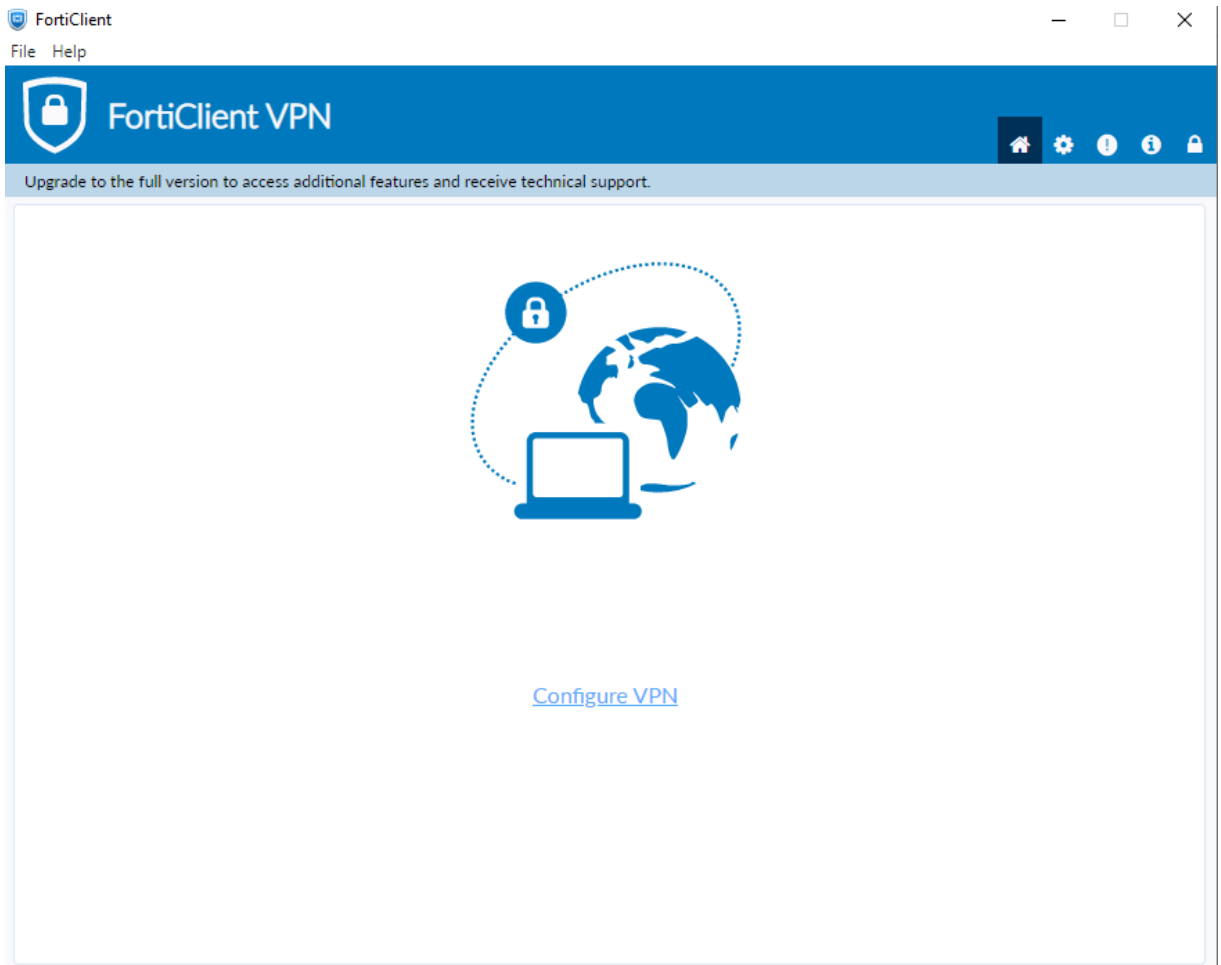
3. Look for a blue shield in your desktop tray. Click it and select *Open FortiClient Console* from the popup menu.:



4. When FortiClient starts up, select the checkbox and click *I accept*. On the following popup, click the link that says *Configure VPN*.



Next, Click on “Configure VPN”



5. Fill in the configuration options as in the following picture, replacing email@pittstate.edu with your @pittstate.edu email address. For students and student employees, this will be your @gus.pittstate.edu address. Save that configuration.
