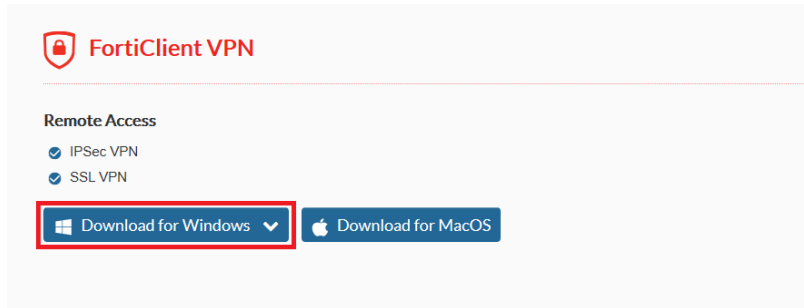
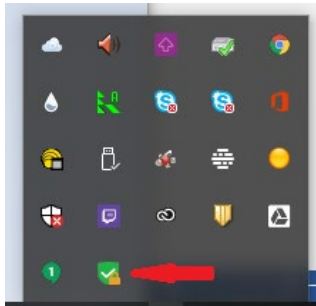


## Pittstate VPN PC

1. Navigate your browser to <https://forticlient.com/downloads> . Select the download for Windows button.

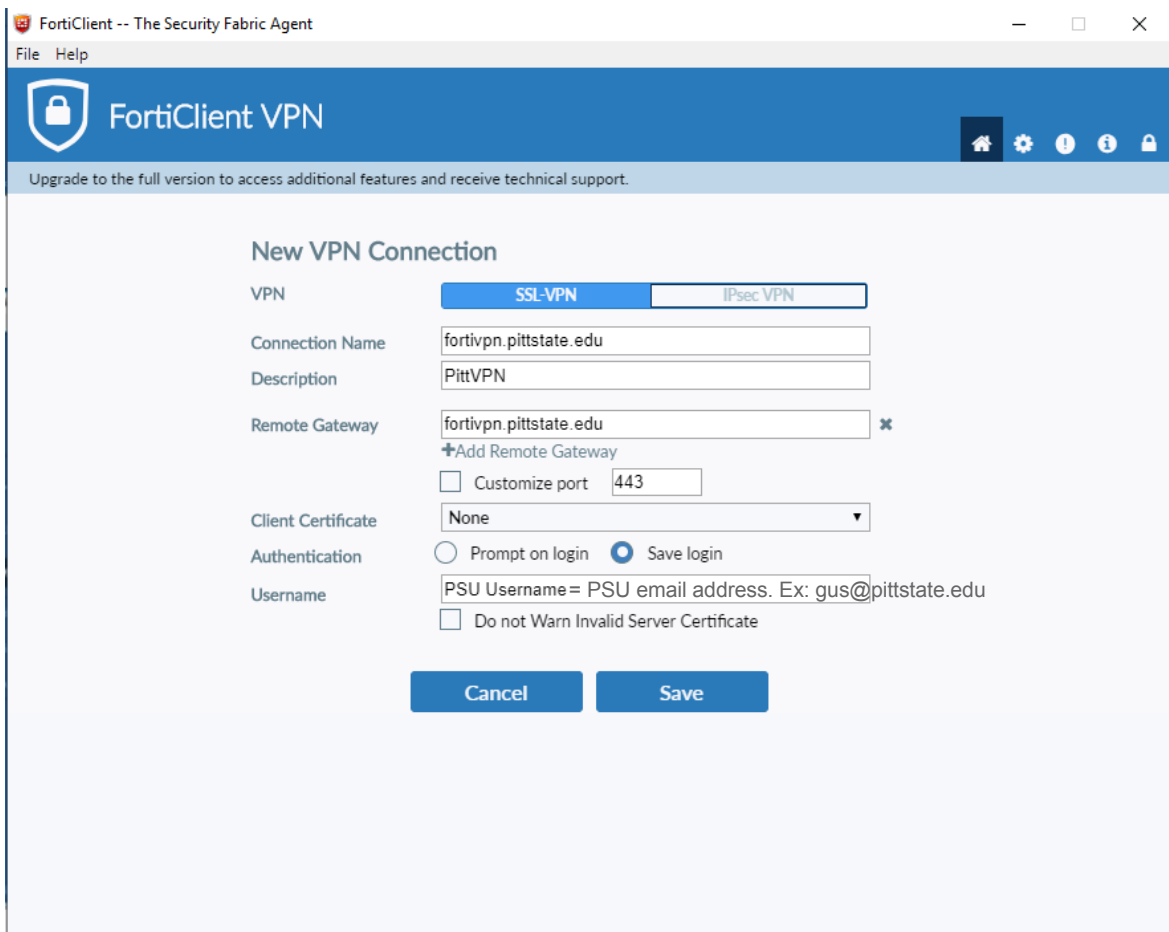


2. You will be asked which windows bit type you are using. If you are unsure which type of windows you have pick 64bit, if you do not have 64bit windows this will fail and you will need to download the 32bit version.
3. Once you have downloaded and installed the client it should be running in your system tray. If now you will need to manually launch it.



4. Click on the FortiClient icon and select the open option, this will open the FortiClient interface. You will be asked to agree to some terms check the box and click I agree .You will then see a window with the link that says Configure VPN, click that link.

5. Using your PSU email address (employees: @pittstate.edu - students: @gus.pittstate.edu), configure FortiClient to match the following, then click save.
