

Retro-Credits Policy

The Modern Languages Retro-credits Program rewards students for their significant prior language experience, such as high school coursework or language spoken at home. Students who desire credit for language proficiency they acquired before coming to PSU should consult with Modern Languages Faculty.

HOW TO APPLY

Students must sign up during the first language class they are enrolled in at PSU. No exceptions or extensions will be granted. Transfer students who took language classes at another university or college are not eligible to apply.

HOW IT WORKS

When students earn an A, B, or C in the course, they receive Retro-credits. See the chart below:
