What is a SANE nurse?

A SANE nurse falls under the umbrella of a forensic nurse and have fulfilled further dedicated education beyond nursing school to assist in caring for individuals who have been victims of sexual violence.

What is the Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner Course?

This is a hybrid 64.0 hour course that meets all the requirements set out by the International Association of Forensic Nurses to become a SANE nurse. This course encompasses the International Association of Forensic Nurses education guidelines to train nurses. In this course you will learn a wide-range of skills from how to perform forensic exams to testifying in court.
