

## Greek Life Terms

## Terms to Know:

**Active -** A fully initiated member of a fraternity/sorority.

**Alumni/Alumnae -** An initiated member of a fraternity/sorority who is no longer in college.

Alumni/Alumnae Advisors - Fraternity/sorority alumnae members who bring experience and guidance to collegiate members and officers.

**Bid** - A formal invitation to join a fraternity/sorority.

**Chapter -** The local group of the larger (inter)national organization, represented by a special Greek letter name.

**Formal Recruitment -** The recruitment period set aside by the Panhellenic Council for membership selection.

**Fraternity -** A Greek letter brotherhood; can also be applied to a women's fraternity

**Hazing -** Any action taken or any situation created intentionally that causes embarrassment, harassment, or ridicule and risks emotional and/or physical harm to members of a group or team, whether new or not, regardless of the person's willingness to participate. PSU has a zero tolerance policy for hazing.

**Initiation -** The formal ceremony during which a new member begins full membership in a fraternity/sorority.

**Legacy -** A potential new member who has a close relative who is a member of a sorority.

**New Member -** A person who has accepted a bid, but has not yet been initiated into a fraternity/sorority.

Greek Life Terms

**Philanthropy -** Projects sponsored by fraternity/sorority chapters to raise money for and awareness about charitable causes and organizations.

**Potential New Member (PNM) -** A full-time PSU student interested in joining a Greek-letter organization.

**New Member Period -** A time during which new members learn about the Greek chapter and its values.

**Reference Letter/Recommendation -** A letter signed by an alumni/alumna recommending an individual for membership in a fraternity/sorority. These letters are NOT required for PSU recruitment.

**Run Out -** An alcohol free social event involving two or more Greek-letter organizations.

**Recruitment -** The mutually selective process by which potential new members and fraternity/sorority members get to know each other for the purposes of membership.

**Recruitment Counselor (Rho Gamma) -** A sorority member who has disaffiliated form her sorority during sorority recruitment so that she can assist potential new members who are interested in joining a sorority.

**Sorority -** A Greek letter sisterhood; sometimes referred to as women's fraternities.

**National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) -** A governing body composed of 26 (inter)national women's fraternities.

**North American Interfraternity Conference (NIC) -** A governing association composed of over 75 (inter)national men's fraternities.

Panhellenic Council (PHC) - The governing body of the NPC sororities at PSU.

Interfraternity Council (IFC) - The governing body of the fraternities at PSU
