Description:

In order to encourage more students, Greeks, clubs, and other university organizations to join in the fun, the Intramural Sports Program has created a point system that allows the awarding of an All-University Champion as well as Divisional Champions at the end of each academic year. The point system provides more incentive for individuals and groups to participate in the Intramural Sports Program by keeping the thrill of competition within its limits and placing a strong emphasis on sportsmanship and having fun through participation.

General Guidelines:

All-University Points will be awarded only for activities in the fall, and spring semesters of an academic year. Teams and organizations must use the same team name for all activities registered for or included on the actual registration form for the team to be credited for participation in that activity. The number of points awarded to a team will depend on the classification of the activity, performance in the activity, forfeits, sportsmanship, and attendance at meetings.

**For a team to receive points as an organization or a residence hall you must be currently be recognized or live in that residence hall for the academic year. All other teams should be, categorized as Independent. The overall champion will be selected based on points accumulated throughout the academic year.

How the Point System Works:

Throughout the year, major, minor and individual/dual sport points are awarded to the top four teams, or individuals in the men's, and women's divisions. In addition to achievement points, sportsmanship, entry points, and championship points can also be earned.

At the end of the year, the organization accumulating the highest point total in each division (men's and women's), is awarded the All-University Championship. Banners displaying the organization name and point total for each year's champion will be displayed in the SRC.

In addition to the All-University title, fraternities, and sororities compete for the Greek points title. The resident halls, independents, and co-op will be competing for their own individual championships. All-University, Greek, Resident Halls, Independent, and Coop points are tracked separately. For example: the fraternity with the highest point total retains the fraternity championship, while the sorority with the highest point total captures the sorority championship. **To qualify for competitive tournaments, teams must have a league record of .500 or better, and a sportsmanship rating of 3.0 or above.** If these guidelines are not met, then those teams will **NOT** qualify for postseason play. Teams that do not make the competitive tournaments will still receive all points accumulated during the league. **Teams who sign up as recreational will not be part of the points system.**

Points:

Entry Points- Points earned for entering an event. These points are earned for having a representative for every team at the assigned captains' meeting. If any team, or individual forfeits during any activity; that individual, or team will lose their entry points for that activity and will be deemed ineligible for postseason play. Only teams at the captains' meeting will earn entry points. For organizations that have multiple teams, each team will need to have a representative at the captains meeting.

IM Points System

Sportsmanship Points- Points earned for good sportsmanship during an activity. IM Staff will rate each team. Teams will receive these points at the end of an activity, based on their total average sportsmanship points. For an organization with multiple teams, including individual/dual activities sportsmanship will be calculated by taking the average of all teams/individuals for that organization. ****At the end of a league if a team does not have an average of 3.0 or better, they will not qualify for the tournament even if they have a record of .500 or better.**

Achievement Points- Points earned for winning a contest (regular season and playoffs).

If any team or individual forfeits out of any sport, that team or individual will lose their achievement points for that activity. Points for winning a game, or match by forfeit will only be added after the first win (not by forfeit) of a: tournament, or league game.

Forfeit Points- Deduction of points for teams, or individuals not showing up for a game. You will lose your entry points, deduction for the forfeit, and will have a \$20 forfeit fee. Teams will also be deemed ineligible for post season tournaments.

Championship Points- Points earned for winning an overall championship.

Classifications:

You may enter as many teams as you like, but only one team in any major sport, two teams in mid-major-minor sport, three teams in dual sports, and only 8 individuals in a tournament per organization. To keep championship points teams must keep the same name for every event including: team, dual, and individual sports.
