Mental Health Therapy

The Student Health Services works in conjunction with University Counseling for treatment of mental health issues such as: stress management, depression, drug & alcohol problems, eating disorders, sexual abuse issues, and relationship problems. Nutritional Counseling

The Student Health Services offers patient consultation and counseling through a contract with a registered dietician. Patient education on such nutritional issues as weight management, eating disorders, and special dietary needs may be scheduled by calling (620)-235-4452. Fee for service.

Dermatology/ ENT/ Orthopedic Services /Cardiology/ Gynecology

The Student Health Center offers consultation and evaluation through contracted specialty physicians. Any student with a chronic or complicated medical condition related to dermatology/ears, nose or throat/orthopedic may be referred by the BSHC medical staff for an appointment to be evaluated by the specialist.
