

NEW ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE

(Current Students)

Beginning Fall 2023, current students will be evaluated at the end of each semester for eligibility for the Associate of Arts in General Studies degree. Eligibility requirements include the following:

- Student must be seeking their first Bachelor degree without an existing Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree.
- Student must have at least 60 credit hours completed (developmental credit hours are not included).
- Student must have at least 15 credit hours completed in residence (courses taken from PSU).
- Student must have completed the General Education program applicable to their University Catalog.
- Student must have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA.

Please note, students who have earned 30 or more credit hours from a single Kansas community college are not eligible for the AA degree from PSU. However, these students may be eligible to participate in Reverse Transfer. Please contact the Registrar's Office at 620-235-4205 for details.

Eligible students will be contacted by the Registrar's Office within three weeks after the conclusion of the semester. Eligible students will be given the option to opt-out of receiving the Associate of Arts degree if they so choose. The Associate of Arts degree will be conferred to those students who did not opt-out within six weeks after the conclusion of the semester. Awarded students will also receive information on a ceremony celebrating their accomplishment.
