





# Careers & Internships

Because of the high demand for our graduates, our students have internship and career oppertunities across the country. For the past 5 years, Wood Product Manufacturing has maintained an average of 25+ recruiting companies a year at Company Day. Students often have 3 or more internships before they graduate, and starting salaries range from \$42,000-\$55,000 plus benefits and with lots of opportunity to grow. Potential careers include engineering/drafting, project management, estimating, production management, operations, CNC programming, sales, and more.
